Horrible Tragedy

The most horrible tragedy ever enacted in Dakota says the Brainerd Tribune, was that at Fort-Land, in the Red River Valley, better known as Portland on the coast. The affair was reported to the Tribune by Mr. Harry Correll, who returned Thursday from the scene. He did not learn the names of the parties but gave the story as follows: A threshing machine was in operation and the feeder accidentally cut the hand of the driver. The feeder snatched the knife and stabbed the hand, completely opening the abdomen, leaving his bowels exposed. The hand cutter seeing that he had been fatally stabbed, and knowing that he had but a few minutes to live, grabbed his murderer, and in his desperation hurled him into the cylinder of the machine, where he was ground in to mince meat, falling back dead himself. Thus both men, through a mere accidental scratch and ill luck, were sent to eternity in a horrible mangled state, even before presentation at the gate of hades.
