The democrats are jubilant over Blaine's letter declining to allow his name to be presented to the national convention. Had Blaine remained in the field he would have swept the country from Maine to California. If he were there are plenty of good men left for presidential candidates, and a republican administration will rule in these United States in 1888.

The correspondent misrepresents the matter when he makes the assertion as there are not a dozen anti-Blaine republicans in this city. Kindred's published in Sunday's Globe, in that gentleman's opinion, the opportunity arising had opposition to the man from Maine. This may be the "large republican element" of which the Brainerd correspondent speaks.

BLAINE'S DECISION. The decision of James G. Blaine to not allow his name to be presented to the convention is to be regretted. That he honestly indicated the nature of his declination there can be no doubt in an honest mind. Full of years and honor he probably desires to turn from the rough life that leads to political victory, and lead the quiet life of a civilian. However this may be, the deadly intensity with which he has worked out from published interviews and carb stone conversations almost any position can be proved. The blaineite claims it is an admitted fact for the nomination, while another asserts that Blaine is out of the race. That Mr. Blaine does not care for the nomination is evident from the tone of his letter, but whether the people will concede to the wishes of this foremost dilettante and most powerful statesman of his age, remains to be seen. There is no man in the republican party who would receive so vigorous and powerful endorsement as James G. Blaine.
