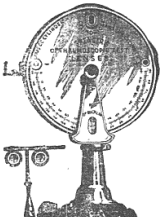

First Blood for Dunn. The application of R. C. Dunn for a mandamus compelling the auditor of Morrison county to issue a certificate of election to the legislature, was heard before Judge Keating and Butler on Monday, and resulted in a peremptory writ of mandamus being issued to Auditor Ellenbeck commanding him to issue a certificate of election to R. C. Dunn. Notice of appeal to the supreme court was given. The Journal-Free, of St. Cloud, says: The judge gave his decision on Tuesday in favor of Mr. Dunn, but it amounts rather to a justification for him and a rebuke to the democratic canvassing board which caused more for a partisan victory than for a sworn duty. The case will be appealed and cannot be heard by the supreme court until after the next legislature shall have met and adjourned. Free's election will now, however, be regularly contested before the legislature, not to that effect having been served on Tuesday. The contest will be brought in the name of S. S. Treby, of Morrison county, on Mr. Dunn's behalf.

Filed a Mortgage. A mortgage was filed yesterday with the secretary of the state, given by the Wadena & Park Rapids Railroad company, to the Minneapolis Trust company. The amount of money advanced is \$450,000, issued in bonds paying 6 per cent interest and redeemable in 1940. The railroad company will build a road from Wadena to Park Rapids, a distance of thirty-six miles, each additional mile of track calling for an issue of bonds for \$15,000.
