THE BOYS' ARMY THINGS.

The Inspection of the B. & N. W. Railway is Entirely Satisfactory. The Company's Works at Blue Lake Looked Over—Everything Moving Along Nicely.

When the proposition was made to Crow Wing county by the Brainerd & Northern Minnesota Railway company to build a road north from Brainerd into the timber country in consideration of \$100,000 in bonds it was agreed that the road should be inspected by a competent man and

accepted, before the bonds were to be issued to the company by the Minnesota Trust company with whom they were placed after being accepted by the county. Accordingly on Monday it was decided to ascertain whether the company had filled up part of the contract and Mr. W. W. Rich, chief engineer of the B. & N. W. Railway, accompanied by Mr. J. E. Glass and Mr. J. E. McGinnis, arrived for that purpose.

A large number of citizens were invited to accompany the party and those who accepted the invitation were: L. O. Levin, John Nover, Henry Spaulding, J. M. E. Hill, John J. Clark, John C. H. Richardson, A. F. Perry, John P. Frater, J. E. Hestler, H. M. Clark, J. W. Koop, Joel Smith, A. F. Farrar, J. J. Howe, A. F. Groves, O. Foster, Lewis C. Johnson, the son, S. F. Alderman, Con. O'Driscoll, M. Westfall, J. N. Gardner, W. S. McGinnis, J. E. Slipp, Frank Bell and N. H. Ingwersen.

The party were taken from the Arlington in rigs to the new passenger freight depot at Brainerd and arrived there at 10:30. From there the party was divided up into groups and a general inspection of the plant of the Northern was made. Many were the large mill being alive and working in all parts of the machinery and placing it in operation. Everyone was well pleased with the progress made and many were surprised that so much work had been accomplished. The machines shown, round houses and all other points of interest were visited and at 2 o'clock the party boarded the train and started northward over the line road.

The engine which pulled the train was the "Josephine," named in honor of the young daughter of Mr. Glass, and was handled by Fred Stillings, while Conductor Charles Heilig and the engineer were respectively G. H. 14, 16, 20, 28, 37 and 42 miles.

The road is not yet quite completed to Grand.

On the return trip the train was stopped at Camp 5 and the passengers were invited to partake of a good hearty dinner and as the hour was 4 o'clock everybody did justice to the sumptuous meal which had been prepared by Sam. Long, the cook. After the train had started on its return trip, and during the trip Inspector Rich paid very particular attention to viewing the road and construction and was highly pleased to find it in such good condition, in fact at many places more than had been done than the specifications in the contract allow, and his report to the Minnesota Trust Co. will be highly satisfactory to all parties interested.

A vote of thanks was tendered to Messrs. Jones and Glass and the company for their generous treatment of the party on board.

A resolution, prepared by Leon E. Levin by request of the commissioners and signed by the three county commissioners on board was as follows:

Resolved, That the Brainerd & Northern Minnesota Railway company be and is in our opinion, fully and satisfactorily performing its contract with Crow Wing county, made pursuant to the terms of the contract contracted to be built by the Northern Minnesota Railway company, we recommend that the road and the delivery of the \$100,000 in bonds.

After this resolution was read a motion was made and unanimously adopted by all on board that the action of the three commissioners be taken.

When the train arrived at the station the teams were found in waiting and the party was left at the Arlington at 5:30.

On Monday regular trains will commence running for the purpose of accommodating the passenger freight business. They will leave Brainerd in the morning and return to Brainerd in the afternoon.

The Northern Mill company has fourteen camps busy at work in the timber in the Grull lake country. Ten of these camps are operated by the company and four by contractor.

They will bank a total of 80,000,000 feet of all kinds of lumber. Brainerd & Northern Minnesota to Brainerd.
