THE NATIONAL DEAD.
Brainerd will Friday observe Memorial Day.

Tuesday was Memorial Day, a day set apart by the nation to be observed in honor of the heroes who gave their lives up for their country's sake. The exercises in Brainerd will be under direct charge of Pat O'Sullivan, C. A. R., and they earnestly request that every old soldier, former member of the Grand Army or not, turn out and march with a procession of the city.

At 9 a. m. on Tuesday morning the march, commanded by Capt. Martin, will form in front of headquarters on Sixth street and march to Evergreen cemetery; the hearse will accompany the procession bearing the flowers for the occasion.

The purpose of the procession is to honor the heroes of the great struggle. The hearse will be followed by the grand march, and Post Captain Huntington will conduct the ritual services.

In the afternoon at 2 o'clock members of the post will form on Sixth street in front of the hall, the Third Regiment Band preceding them, and march to the high school on Eighth street south, where the saluting of the flag will take place.

The city schools will then form in line and the procession will move up Eighth street to Front, thence west to Sixth and north to Gregory Square, where the direction of J. C. Congdon, master of the day. Here the exercises will be made by Rev. P. L. Lynch, Rev. J. A. Jenkins, Rev. E. G. Sanderson and H. C. Stevens. Music will be furnished by the Germania Men's chorale and the band and school children.

The annual memorial sermon will be delivered by J. C. Congdon, pastor of the Congregational Church on Sunday evening, May 29th. A program of songs respecting to attend in a body at that occasion.
