Liquor Law Changes.

Several liquor laws were passed by the legislature which are important in their nature, and which are heralded with much favor by the temperance people, among the most important being the following, according to the Tribune:

One law prohibits saloons from selling, giving away or disposing of liquor to any person to whom sold. This law is to stop the practice, so prevalent in the case of saloons, of selling liquors saloons after buckets and jugs of liquor.

Another law prohibits the sale of liquor on the state fair grounds; another prohibits county commissioners or city councils from granting licenses to any person to open a saloon near 300 feet of any school house.
