Ray Jones Wins from the Measles. Judge R. R. Nelson, of the federal court, has ruled at St. Paul a decision in the case of the Measles. Ray Jones, in which he gave judgment quiting the title in the complainant, who acted in the position of the Indian chief, certain land at Third River Falls, granted under a treaty. It is held that the words "best advantage" in the Indian treaty, where there is no provision for land patents to be issued, is not to be construed as a title to or interest in the lands selected by the reserve, that he could acquire a valid lease thereon, and that it was not necessary that such lease should be approved by the secretary of the interior.
