FEVER IS RAGING

INCREASE OF CASES AT NEW ORLEANS IS ALARMING.

Whitman New Cases Was the Day's Record and is the Largest Since the Fever First Made its Appearance—No Deaths Reported and Patients All Doing Well—Deaths at District-Mobile Jail—No New Cases at Cairo.

New Orleans, Sept. 22.—The largest number of cases reported on any day since the yellow fever first made its appearance in New Orleans two weeks ago was recorded on the books of the board of health yesterday evening at 6 o'clock, although at that hour not a single case had proved fatal during the day. There were eighteen cases in all, including nine by Dr. Joseph Holt, all of the latter having been of a mild nature and been put under quarantine regulations.

The most sensational incident of the day was the announcement from Dr. Holt, expressed to the board of health, that he had discovered six cases of yellow fever in the city, which had come under his observation on Thursday. Immediately upon the receipt of the letter the majority of the board of health ordered a number of inspectors were sent to the various parts of the city to make a search for cases. The places were all visited, but the board said it had detected no cases since all those who had been under quarantine since the first case was reported from the infected houses.
