PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS. To be submitted to the people for their approval or rejection at the General Election to be held on Tuesday, November 6th, 1877.

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SECTIONS ONE AND TWENTY-FOUR OF ARTICLE FOUR, AND SECTION TWO OF ARTICLE FIVE OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION.

of the legislature. SECTION 24. The senators shall be chosen by single districts of convenient, nearly equal territory, at the same time that members of the lower representatives are required to be chosen in the same manner, and no representative district shall be divided in the formation of a senate district.

SECTION 2 (Article 5). The returns of every election for the officers named in the foregoing section shall be made to the secretary of state, who shall call to his assistance two or more of the judges of the supreme court, and two disinterested judges of the district courts of the state, who shall constitute a board of canvassers, who shall open and count all the returns and declare the result within three days after such canvass.

SECTION 3. Each stockholder in any corporation shall be liable only for all unpaid installments on stock owned by him, or transferred for the purpose of evading creditors.
