If the coveys are left undisturbed until August 25th, they will be able to find abundance of game, and we are sure that there were never so many birds in the southern part of the county as this year, with the exception of open water and favorable weather.

By the time the season opens the prairie birds will be so numerous that it will be difficult to take care of themselves and not to be that wholesale slaughter that would result if they were not protected. The law is enforced and this provides for the future of the game laws should be prosecuted.
