Action has been commenced against the Brainerd school district for \$20,000 by Charles Banks for damages alleged to have been received by the district on July 15th, 1893, by an eight-year-old son while playing on the grounds of the Third ward school house last fall. The complaint sets forth that the said foot was caught under a stump and that was thrown to the ground and his foot was broken and that he was injured and was compelled to be amputated. The suit is brought in Hennepin county. As a special master of the school board was not readily available, W. S. McClanahan was employed as counsel to represent the district.
